

Weekly Discussion Guide – 7-16-2023

“Guess Who”

1 Kings 19:15-21; 2 Kings 2:1-15

1. Do you have an Elijah-type person who has invested in your life? How has that impacted your life? How do you think it has impacted their life?
2. Do you have an Elisha-type person who you are investing in? How has that impacted your life? How do you think it has impacted their life?
3. Is your life being lived in a way that reflects that your greatest contribution to the world will be who you invest your life in? If not, what changes do you need to make?
4. We’ve talked multiple times in this sermon series about priorities. To help us prioritize, it can be helpful to think: *Fifty years from now, what decision would my grandchildren (biological or spiritual) want me to have made?* Is there a situation you are facing in which this is a helpful question to ask?
5. Pastor Hunter mentioned that God gives us callings on our life that are too big for us to fulfill on our own. What do you think God’s calling on your life is?

The work of discipleship is not our work, but is the work of the Holy Spirit. Spend time praying that the Holy Spirit would show you what He wants you to do to better invest your life in others.

6. What do you feel like the Holy Spirit might be saying to you?
