## "Jesus and the Man Born Blind" John 9:1-12

1.	Read John 9:1-41. What themes in this story have you heard before in Jesus' encounters in the Gospel of John?
2.	Based on their question to Jesus, what did the disciples assume about the blind man?
3.	How did Jesus answer their question?
4.	How does this teach us to look at suffering, especially negative circumstances we don't understand or can't explain?
5.	The sermon invited us to go from asking "Whose fault?" to "Whose glory?" How are you seeing God's glory recently through good times or struggle? Is there a place you need to see His glory?
6.	When the blind man is interrogated about Jesus, what is his response in John 9:25? If you had to sum up what God has done for you in just a sentence or two like this, what would you say?

7. Is God speaking a specific word of invitation or challenge to you through this

encounter? What's your take-away?
