"They Kept Silent and Listened" Acts 15:1-33

- 1. Read Acts 15:1-33. What was the issue of conflict?
- 2. What seems to be the spirit in which this conflict was handled? Use supporting evidence from the passage.
- 3. David Augsburger has said, "being heard is so close to being loved that for the average person, they are almost indistinguishable." Can you think of a specific instance or relationship in which this has been true for you?
- 4. Have you experienced a time when you felt unloved because you felt unheard?
- 5. In Acts 15, it seems apparent that even though there was conflict, the leaders had hearts of peace. What does it look like practically to have a heart of peace in a conflict situation or toward another person who has a heart of war?
- 6. How can we guard against having a heart of war even when we feel threatened?
- 7. Think of a current or recent conflict situation. What would it look like to practice curiosity in the midst of this conflict?
