“Giving God Our Hearts” Matthew 22:34-40

1. If the “heart” involves our desires, passions, and affections, to what things and people have you given your heart?
2. Read Proverbs 3:5-8, Proverbs 4:20-27, Matthew 22:34-40, Jeremiah 29:10-14. As you read each passage, pray for God to use one word or phrase to capture your attention. What’s the word or phrase?
3. Do you sense God saying something specific through this word or phrase? Does it stir up any feelings? Do you sense God wanting you to respond to it in a specific way?
4. In the sermon, Pastor Jonathan said, “When we give God our heart, our heart doesn’t divide. It multiplies.” What about this statement resonates with you? What resistance do you feel?
5. When have you felt like your heart was divided? Can you think of an example when giving God your heart allowed it to be multiplied and given to other people or things as well?
6. Are there any habits in your life right now that are keeping you from giving God your whole heart? Are there habits in your life that express that God has your heart? Are there any changes you want to make to your habits in this season to give more of your heart to God?
