

Weekly Discussion Guide – 5-12-2024

“Two Ways About It”
Matthew 7:13-29

1. Describe one or more time(s) where one choice changed the trajectory of your life.
2. Read Matthew 7:13-29. What part of this section do you feel most challenged by and why?
3. Name some examples from your own life of “broad road, wide gate” opportunities or choices and “narrow road, small gate” opportunities or choices.
4. From your own knowledge of scripture, including the Sermon on the Mount that we’ve been studying, what might good and bad fruit look like today? How can we spot it?
5. Go to biblegateway.com, type the word “fallen” into the search field where it says, “Enter passage, keyword, or topic,” pick a Bible translation, then hit Enter. Scan the results. How might some of these scriptures connect with Jesus’ final sentence in His Sermon on the Mount (Matt. 7:27)?
6. Ask and allow the Holy Spirit to help you answer: In what area of your life have you been saying “no” to Jesus (whether intentionally or not)? Is there an area where you need to acknowledge your choices are related to saying “yes” or “no” to Jesus?
