- 1. Does your family (either your family of origin or the family you live with now) have an identity? Describe that identity.
- 2. Paul lists a number of the ways we follow the desires of our sinful nature in Gal. 5:19-21. Many of these are likely culturally relevant to the Galatians. What are some of the specific ways in which you follow the desires of your sinful nature?
- 3. Which one of these expressions of love do you think you bear the most? Which one do you think you bear the least?

4. Ask two people close to you:

Which one of these do you think I express the most? Which one of these do you think I express the least?

Are you surprised by their answer? What does their answer reveal to you?

- 5. Paul invites us to "use your freedom to serve one another in love" (Gal. 5:13). What is one way you're committing to serve someone in love this week?
