A Letter from Your Discipleship Pastor...

Dear Mulder Church family,

I have a favorite word. I don't know if that's a normal thing: for someone to have a favorite word. But I recognize that I'm not normal. So maybe it's just me. But I have a favorite word.

That favorite word isn't even an English word. It's a Greek word. That word is the word: "Telos" (or, in Greek, $\tau \epsilon \lambda o \zeta$) Telos isn't easy to translate into English, but if we were to translate it, I think the best translation is this: the ultimate purpose or end toward which something is directed.

Maybe an example would help: every Saturday in the fall, thousands of young men don helmets of crimson, white, orange, blue, and any number of other inferior colors for one *telos*: to win a national championship. Everything these men do, from what they eat to who they associate with to how they spend their free time is centered around that one objective. A national championship, their *telos*, is not just the finish line, but the *reason for the very existence of the team*. At least, that's true for some teams. Every coach that hopes to be playing the first weekend of December and into January wants each player to have that *telos*. That's how a team wins a championship.

Why is all of this in a church newsletter? Because it's important to be reminded of our *telos*, both as individuals and as a church. Our telos, as we talked about this summer in our "This is the Way" sermon series, is for each person to live a life centered around 3 goals: to be with Jesus, become like Jesus, and do as He did. This is the *telos* of our spiritual formation, of our walk with Christ.

We call the process this involves "discipleship." Aligning my life around those three goals, and helping others to do the same, is one of my core passions in life. That's why I'm excited to share that the Staff Parish Relations Committee has approved a title change for me from Associate Pastor to Discipleship Pastor.

This is more of a response to what my role at Mulder has become rather than a new role for me. Core to my calling as a pastor is the desire to see people grow in their discipleship under Jesus: their growth in being with Jesus, becoming like Him, and doing as He did. Among my other responsibilities, I will continue my work in overseeing groups and classes here at Mulder—empowering leaders to create environments conducive to transformation into the image of Jesus—and meeting with you in your home, at the hospital, in my office, or over lunch or coffee as we seek together to hear God's voice beckoning "Come, follow me."

Your *telos*, and mine too, is to be with, become like, and do as our rabbi, Jesus, did. This is the reason for our very existence. I'm excited and honored to play a part in walking alongside you as we aim for that *telos*.
