

A Letter from Your Senior Pastor...

Making Disciples from Mulder to Mexico!

On June 27, a team from Mulder Church will travel to Ensenada, Mexico and partner with Yugo Ministries to build two homes for families in need. We're grateful to share that our team has grown to 18 people this year including several youths, making this a truly intergenerational mission trip. While you may not be traveling with us, you can still be part of the mission through your prayers and financial support.

The team will split into two groups to build two houses with a projected cost of \$8,350 per home. The church's designated missions fund covers these construction costs. Each team member has an out-of-pocket cost of \$1,750 per person. Last year, church members also helped to provide furnishings and essential items like beds, linens, curtains, tables, appliances, cabinets, and food. These "wish list" items made a meaningful impact for the family. Our goal this year toward these furnishings is \$6,000.

You can support the mission by giving toward:

- Individual team members (\$1,750/person)
- House construction costs (\$8,350/home)
- Furnishings and family support items (\$6,000 total)
