Who's Responsible? – Part 2: “What's the Son's Part?”

1. When you think about Jesus, do you tend to picture Him more in the past (Gospels), present, or future (His return)? Why do you think that is? And what do you picture Him doing?
2. Which of the six activities of Jesus stood out to you most, and why? (Ruling, Building His Church, Interceding for Us, Preparing a Place for Us, Waiting in Mercy, Making All Things New)
3. What was one misconception about Jesus addressed in the sermon that challenged or corrected your thinking?
4. Read **Mark 16:19**, **Hebrews 10:12–13**, and **1 Peter 3:22**. How should the knowledge that Jesus is ruling and reigning *right now* shape the way we view current events or personal struggles?
5. Jesus said, “I will build my church” (**Matthew 16:18**). Where have you seen evidence of Jesus building His Church? Why is it important to know this is His job, and we are His ambassadors?
6. How would your prayer life or sense of security change if you truly believed Jesus is praying for you right now (**Romans 8:34**)?
7. **Second Peter 3:9** says Jesus is waiting in mercy. Who in your life might God be giving more time to? How does that affect how you relate to them?
8. **Second Corinthians 5:17** says new creation has already begun. Where do you see evidence of Jesus making you new, and where are you resistant to that work?
9. Based on this message, what is one concrete way you can align your life this week with what Jesus is already doing? (Examples: surrendering control, engaging in community, talking with someone about faith, practicing trust, saying yes to inner transformation)
