

## Weekly Discussion Guide – 5-3-2026

*Who's Responsible? – Part 4: “Why Is the World Falling Apart?”*

Texts: Ephesians 2:1-5, Romans 8:20-23, 2 Kings 6:8-23

1. When you hear the question, “What have you lived through?”, what comes to mind for you? How have those experiences shaped the way you see the world?
2. Read **Ephesians 2:1–5**. How would you describe the roles of the world, the flesh, and the devil in your own words?
3. Which of those three do you tend to notice most in your life or in society? Which do you tend to overlook, and why?
4. Paul says, “all of us also lived among them.” Why is it important to remember that we are not just victims of a broken world, but also participants in it?
5. Read **Romans 8:20–23**. What stands out to you about the idea of creation “groaning”? How does this reshape the idea that the world is simply falling apart?
6. The message said, “Clarity reduces fear, but certainty is not guaranteed.” Where do you find yourself wanting certainty? What would it look like to trust God with clarity instead?
7. Read **2 Kings 6:8-23**. What changed for Elisha’s servant when his eyes were opened?
8. Do you find it easy or difficult to believe those who are with you are more than those who are against you in your current circumstances? Why?
9. Where might you need God to give you a bigger perspective right now?
