

A Letter from Your Discipleship Pastor...

“There is a cloud.” After looking out on the horizon seven times to see if God would break the three-year drought that had covered the land, this was essentially the report Elijah’s servant came back with (1 Kings 18).

“There is a cloud.” That’s also the report that Zach Meerkreebs, the preacher at the Asbury University Chapel that turned into a 16-day revival, gave to Church of the City New York when guest preaching there in 2025, two years after the Asbury Outpouring.

And now, as reports come out showing an increase in church attendance, renewed interest in spirituality, and personal commitments to Jesus—particularly among Gen Z and Millennial adults, I think we can safely say, “There are clouds.”

Clouds of revival? It seems so. Clouds of the next Great Awakening in the United States? Possibly. Clouds of renewal in millions of people? Undoubtedly.

We’re seeing it all over. The Asbury Outpouring in 2023. Four straight years of increase in personal commitments to Jesus by American adults after well over a decade of decline. Studies showing that Gen Z adults attend church more regularly than any other generation.

Last week, at the Awakening Project conference in Wilmore, Kentucky, Haley and I got to experience the joy, commitment, and fervor with which Gen Z is following Jesus. 500 young people worshipped until the wee hours of the morning, passionately celebrated while professing the Apostles’ Creed, joined discipleship bands of accountability, and gave their lives to serving God in their communities, college campuses, and around the world. Clouds on the horizon, ushering in renewal in this nation.

When you’re around those who are awakened to the power and love of God, it becomes contagious. That’s one of the many reasons I’m so excited for us to welcome **Logan Brendle for a night of worship and testimony on July 19** as she shares firsthand stories from the Asbury Outpouring and songs that were born out of that season.

We see the clouds of awakening here at Mulder, too. Preparing for a new building because we’ve outgrown our space, particularly children’s and youth space. An increase in the number of people seeking discipleship through Sunday School classes. Multiple baptisms we’ve had this spring, particularly youth.

If you’ve been sitting on the sidelines waiting for the rain of God’s renewal and revival to come, wait no longer. Clouds are on the horizon. Make corporate worship a priority. Join a Sunday School this summer or a Grow Group this fall. Serve God through one of the many serving opportunities at Mulder. Pray for an increase in the harvest God is sending.

There are clouds of awakening on the horizon. Pray that God soaks His world, this nation, this community, and your life with the renewing rains of revival.
