

## A Letter from Your Senior Pastor...

Dear Mulder Church family,

Thanks to our church's vision, passion, and generosity toward missions, nineteen of us from Mulder Church are presently (June 29–July 2) constructing houses for the Castillo-Perez family and the Olivera-Torres family. Through special donations and continued giving to our Missions Fund, our church paid for the construction costs of both houses, fulfilled both families' entire wish list of other needs for the home, purchased solar-powered audio Bibles in Spanish for each family, and every missionary on our team received some level of financial assistance. On behalf of our whole team, *thank you!*



I'm excited to introduce you to the two families whose homes we're building. The Olivera-Torres family consists of three generations. Bryan and Itzamar both grew up in Ensenada without a father figure. Their paths crossed while working at a medical factory. They are raising their 8-month-old daughter, Bianca.

Also living with them is Itzamar's mother, Francisca, who is raising another granddaughter, Sofia who's 3 years old. They have been sharing a small rental house for which they pay \$2,500 pesos per month. Additionally, they are paying \$3,000 pesos a month for the land on which we are building. With Bryan earning approximately \$3,000 pesos per week, they have little margin to provide for the basic needs of their family.

The Castillo-Perez family is made up of Edwin and Diana who have been together for almost 18 years and their two children, Alexia (15) and Edwin, Jr. (8). For many years they lived renting, until, with great effort, they managed to begin paying for their own land. There they built a small room that, although it represents a great relief from having to continue renting, does not provide adequate conditions. The roof leaks, and the floor is not concrete, so during the rainy season water easily gets inside. Edwin works in a tortilla shop earning \$3,600 pesos, while Diana dedicates herself to the home. They make monthly payments of \$3,500 pesos for the land.



Each of these families are connected to Yugo through their pastors. Wednesday night, we will get the unforgettable experience of worshiping with them in their local churches. Thank you for your generosity, your prayers for our team, and your prayers for these families whose names and faces we now know – real people encountering a real Savior through real strangers who have been found by His love. To Him be the glory!

## Route 56 Pool Party:

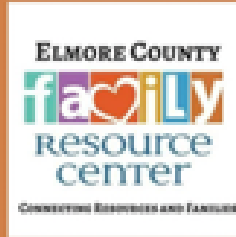

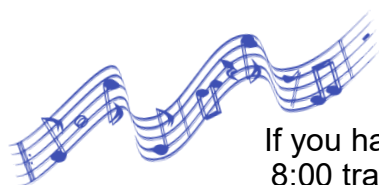


## Celebrate Recovery
